

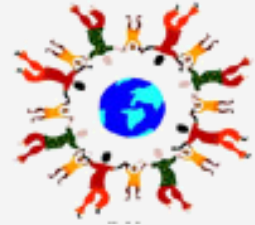
# Interfaith Center For Racial Justice (ICRJ)
